“The Early Years Learning Framework”



The Early Years Learning Framework is a document that underpins our practice at Rainbow Preschool. Developed by the Australian and state and territory governments with input from the early childhood sector and academics, it provides the framework to support and promote children’s learning, and highlights the importance of play-based learning, communication and language, and social and emotional development for children.

The Early Years Learning Framework begins by acknowledging that “children’s lives are characterised by Belonging, Being and Becoming”. Belonging recognises that “children belong first to a family, cultural group, a neighbourhood and a wider community” and the importance of creating a sense of belonging. “Being recognises the significance of the here and now in children’s lives”, and becoming recognises that children grow and develop rapidly through the early years and “emphasises learning to participate fully and actively in society” (Early Years Learning Framework for Australia).

Security at Preschool

Please remember to shut the front gate, classroom doors and the side gate as you come in and as you exit. We need to keep our children safe and as you would know our 3-5 year olds can be very quick off the mark. We also need to be mindful of the security implications. Thank you for your consideration.

As an added security measure please **DO NOT** tell your children the security code! We have had children let themselves out of the preschool gate as they know the code. This could potentially be very dangerous, and is also costly as we need a locksmith to change the codes.
